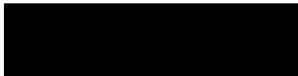

Dear Mr. Craig:

This is in reply to your request submitted under the *Access to Information Act* for:
“Please provide documentation or analysis prepared in advance of the “investment” provided to Ford Motor Company of Canada Ltd. in March 2017 that examines the impact to greenhouse gas emissions as a result of funding Ford’s activities. Please be sure to include documentation or analysis related to any upstream and downstream impacts to greenhouse gases as a result of the funding agreement. The time frame for this request is January 1, 2016 to March 31, 2017.”

I regret to inform you that a search of the records under the control of Innovation, Science and Economic Development Canada has revealed no records relating to the subject of your request.

Our program officials have advised that there was no documentation or analysis undertaken that examined the impact to greenhouse gas emissions as a result of Ford’s activities. In accordance with the Automotive Innovation Fund’s authorities, the program was not required to undertake an environmental assessment of the project in order to secure approvals.

Please be advised that you are entitled to complain to the Information Commissioner concerning the processing of your request within 60 days after the day that you become aware that grounds for a complaint exist.
