Dear Mr. Craig:

This is in response to your request under the *Access to Information Act* (ATIA), received by Transport Canada on December 18, 2017, for the following information:

“Please provide documentation on the number of ships, by year, that brought oil, gas and other petroleum products into Canada port authorities port between 2015-2017. Please also indicate the number of those ships that had their cargo (oil, gas and other petroleum products) subjected to an “upstream and downstream” emissions review. Please also include documentation on any “upstream and downstream” emissions reviews underway or being developed.”

A thorough search of records under the control of Transport Canada was conducted and no records were found pertaining to your request. We suggest that you contact the relevant Canada Port Authorities directly as they may have the information you are seeking.
