On May 24, 2024, your request for access was received by the Access and Privacy Branch requesting the following records from Manitoba Environment and Climate Change:

"Please provide all documents showing money being spent on or planned to be spent electric vehicle chargers this year and for the past two fiscal years. Please only provide final versions of documents if possible (and if final exists, exclude draft versions of that documents). Include documents in which Cabinet confidences can be severed, however, exclude documents in which it cannot be severed. Eliminate duplicate email reply to chains.

Timeframe 4/1/2022 -6/24/2024".

On July 18, 2024, Esther Ifeanyi contacted you and asked if it's okay to provide the cost in an excel format, in your response you stated you were fine with that, and your access request was revised as:

"Please provide the money being spent on or planned to be spent on electric vehicle chargers this year and for the past two fiscal years.

Timeframe 4/1/2022-6/24/2024"

Environment and Climate Change has searched its record, and it's pleased to inform you that your request for access has been granted in full.
