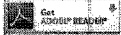



1.3	BG introduced WW who described the present condition of the vessel; the restoration will be complete down to the keel including engines, interiors, mechanical and electrical systems. WW acknowledged that there is a preference to have the vessel become a teaching facility for cadets and adding 6 additional bunks, the sewage system will have to be upgraded to meet present day standards.
