Re: Your request for access to information under Part 2 of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*;

On December 19th, 2011, the City Clerk's Department received your request for access to the following records:

"Please provide a copy of the manual for the photo radar equipment used by mobile photo radar vehicles in Winnipeg."

Access to these records is refused as the Winnipeg Police Service does not have custody or control of the records you are requesting. The exception to the disclosure of these records is pursuant to section 7(1) of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. These records are held by a third party business.

Right of access

7(1) Subject to this Act, an applicant has a right of access to any record in the custody or under the control of a public body, including a record containing personal information about the applicant.
