**RE: Your Access to Information Request Number FNMR03-2010**

Thank you for your access to information request received in this office on June 10, 2010, requesting access to:

“Please provide documentation of expenditures on promotional items in 2008-09 and 2009-10. Include items such as t-shirts, hand bags, stress balls, key chains, mugs and other give-away items that are used for promotion (do not include brochures, flyers or printed signage). Further, please include a breakdown of costs associated with sponsorship of events (list events – golf tournaments, hockey tournaments, etc.), teams or groups (eg. Sponsorship of boat racing team, etc.)”

This is to inform you that the 30 day response period has been extended an additional 30 days, pursuant to:

- subclause 12(1)(a)(i) of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* as your “...application is for access to a large number of records or necessitates a search through a large number of records and completing the work within the original period would unreasonably interfere with the operations of the government institution.”

If you would like to exercise your right to request a review of this decision, you may do so by completing a “Request for Review” form and forwarding it to the Saskatchewan Information and Privacy Commissioner within one year of this notice. Your completed form can be sent to #503 – 1801 Hamilton Street, Regina, Saskatchewan, S4P 4B4. This form is available at the same location which you applied for access or by contacting the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner at (306) 787-8350.


