Re: Your Access to Information Request Number PSC 1213-01G

Thank you for your access to information request received in this office on May 23, 2012, requesting access to, "documentation on the number of sick days accrued for each department for 2011-12. Please distinguish between in-scope and out of scope. Please include overall totals and the cost of such leave. (see response PSC 1112-02G for the way the information is usually provided)"

This is to inform you that your access request has been fully granted, with one small exception -- per section 24(1) of *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (the Act); the information for one identifiable individual was removed from the calculations. Enclosed is a record containing the number of sick days used, number of sick days used per full-time equivalent (FTEs), dollars paid for sick leave used, and number of sick days accrued. As requested, the reports show the breakdown by ministry, in-scope and out-of-scope, and overall totals.

For your information, I have included a copy of the above noted section of the Act.

If you would like to exercise your right to request a review of this decision, you may do so by completing a "Request for Review" form and forwarding it to the Saskatchewan Information and Privacy Commissioner within one year of this notice.
