Method

Canadian online survey via Leger's LEO panel, with n=1612 Canadian residents aged 18+.

When


20th to 22nd of September 2024, inclusive

Margin of error

For comparison purposes, a probability sample of this size (n=1612) yields a margin of error no greater than $\pm 2.4\%$, (19 times out of 20)




Detailed Results






Three-in-five (59%) disagree with a national ban on the sale of new gas, diesel and hybrid vehicles by 2035, with 39% strongly opposing the ban.

Disagreement with the ban is highest among Canadians aged 35+, western Canadians, and rural residents compared to their counterparts. In contrast, men, those aged 18-34, urban residents, university graduates (43% vs. 23% lesser educated), and BIPoC individuals (39% vs. 27% who are white) are more likely to agree with the ban.




Q. The federal government's zero-emission vehicle standard will effectively ban the sale of new gas, diesel and hybrid vehicles by 2035. Do you agree or disagree with a national ban on the sale of new gas, diesel and hybrid vehicles?





When considering only those with an opinion, opposition to the ban rises to 67%, with 45% who strongly disagree with the sale of gas-powered vehicles.
