Note 1 - The Government of Canada's fiscal year begins on April 1st and ends on March 31st in the following calendar year. All Government of Canada financial reporting (external and internal) is done by fiscal year.

Note 2 – Expenditures include all food related expenses incurred by the Prime Minister's Residence. In addition to household groceries, it also includes food expenditures for events that are hosted at the residence.

Note 3 - As per a longstanding practice in place since 1985, the prime minister reimburses amounts related to food based on Statistics Canada data on household spending, which is adjusted using the consumer price index to account for inflation.
